<b>Program Description</b>	If you are a faculty member, we will repay your loan. In return, you serve at an eligible health professions school.

<b>Financial Benefits</b>	<p>If you receive an award, you will get:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Up to \$40,000 in loan repayment assistance</li> <li>• Funding to offset the tax burden</li> </ul>
<b>Tax Liability</b>	We tax the full loan repayment award. You may receive a tax liability benefit equal to 39 percent of the loan repayment amount.

<b>Eligibility Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• U.S. citizen (born or naturalized), U.S. national, or lawful permanent resident</li> <li>• You come from a disadvantaged background. We base this on environmental and economic factors.</li> <li>• You are a faculty member at an approved health professions school. You must have a contract for two years or more.</li> </ul>
